

Holy Communion outside of mass

In light of a number of inquiries regarding the policy for the distribution of Holy Communion Outside of Mass, the following clarification is being offered:

The distribution of Holy Communion Outside of is intended for those who are unable to make the communal celebration of the Holy Eucharist (Sick, homebound, nursing homes, etc.) or in areas where a priest is unable to be present to celebrate Holy Mass on Sundays. Such celebrations are not intended to be an equal choice with participation at Holy Mass. USCCB: Weekday celebrations of Mass §4. & Redemptions Sacramentum § 165.

Holy Communion Outside of Mass nay only be administered for a just cause, in which case it falls to the competence of the Bishop to grant permission. CIC §918. Such a celebration is not intended for weekdays, especially when Holy Mass is celebrated on the preceding or following Sunday. Redemptionis Sacramentum §166.

When daily Mass is *not* celebrated in the Parish, due to the absence of the priest or the inability to find a replacement, a schedule with the celebration of Holy Mass in neighboring parishes is to be provided in place of distributing Holy Communion within the Liturgy of the Word. USCCB: Weekday Celebrations of Mass §2.

If it is currently the practice to provide such weekday "services" in the parish, pastors are encouraged to instruct the faithful on the importance of attending Holy Mass with reception of Holy Communion and to pray for priestly vocations.
